




# Instructions For Multi-load Grease Gun

#### **CARTRIDGE LOADING (Figure A & B)**

- Remove the grease gun head from the grease gun by unscrewing it
- While holding barrel assembly pull plunger rod back. Remove lid from the grease cartridge and insert the cartridge into the barrel.
- Re-attach the grease gun head by screwing it into the barrel assembly so that the cartridge sits well against the follower cup.
- Once in position, press the secure lock lever & push the plunger rod firmly into the barrel







## **DIRECT BULK LOADING (Figure C)**

- Remove the grease gun head from the grease gun by unscrewing it.
- Insert the open end of the barrel into the bulk grease and pull the plunger rod all the way back until barrel is full.
- Reattach the grease gun head by screwing it into the barrel assembly.
- Once in position, press the secure lock lever & push the plunger rod firmly into the barrel

## **DIRECT BULK LOADING (Figure D)**

- 1. Wipe the loader fitting clean.
- Connect loader fitting located on the head of the gun to the valve of the loader pump.
- Run the loader pump until the gun is filled with grease.

#### TROUBLE SHOOTING

#### Pump head is not dispensing

A common reason why grease guns DONOT prime or dispense is due to air pockets. In order to get rid of air pockets, Press the 'Air-Bleeder' or alternately loosen the gun head ½-a-turn & pump a few strokes & then tighten the head.
